Bradley Davis is an Assistant Professor of History at Eastern Connecticut State University in the United States. His first book manuscript concerns the Black Flag Army and the China-Vietnam Borderlands during the nineteenth century. With the EFEO, he helped launch the Yao Script Project in northern Vietnam, a continuing effort to promote the use of traditional character scripts among Yao communities. HIs most current research examines ethnographic practices in northern and central Nguyen Vietnam before and after the French Protectorate.
