Hue-Tam Ho Tai teaches Vietnamese history at Harvard University. Her particular area of interest is the social history of Vietnam in the 20th century. She is the author of Millenarianism and Peasant Politics in Vietnam (1983); Radicalism and the Origins of the Vietnamese Revolution (1992) and Passion, Betrayal and Revolution in Colonial Saigon (2010); in addition she edited The Country of Memory: Remaking the Past in Late Socialist Vietnam (2001) and is the co-editor of State, Society and the Market in Contemporary Vietnam: Power, Property and Values (forthcoming, Routledge).
