Li Qingxin earned his doctorate in history from Nankai University, and now directs the history program at the Sun Yat-sen Institute at the Guangdong Academy of Social Sciences, and the Center for Guangdong Maritime History Studies, where he is Editor of Maritime History Studies (in Chinese and English). His recent publications include The Seaside World: Studies on the History of Trade in the South China Sea and Sino-Foreign Relations (2010), The Overseas Trade System of Ming Dynasty (2007), Nanhai and Maritime Silk Road (2010), and The Maritime Silk Road (in Chinese and in English, 2006). He is currently researching overseas Chinese and Vietnamese society in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, the social and economic history of the coastal world from South China to Vietnam, and the maritime history of maritime Guangdong.
