

**Vu Duc Liem** is a lecturer in history at Hanoi National University of Education. He is currently working on his second MA thesis in Southeast Asian Studies at Chulalongkorn University with financial support from the Rockefeller Foundation. His research focuses on the politico-economic history of eighteenth- and early nineteenth-century Vietnam in the Mekong delta region, in particular the regional impact of Siamese and Vietnamese state-making projects and the influence of highland-lowland interactions on changes in the political landscape of early nineteenth-century Vietnam.
